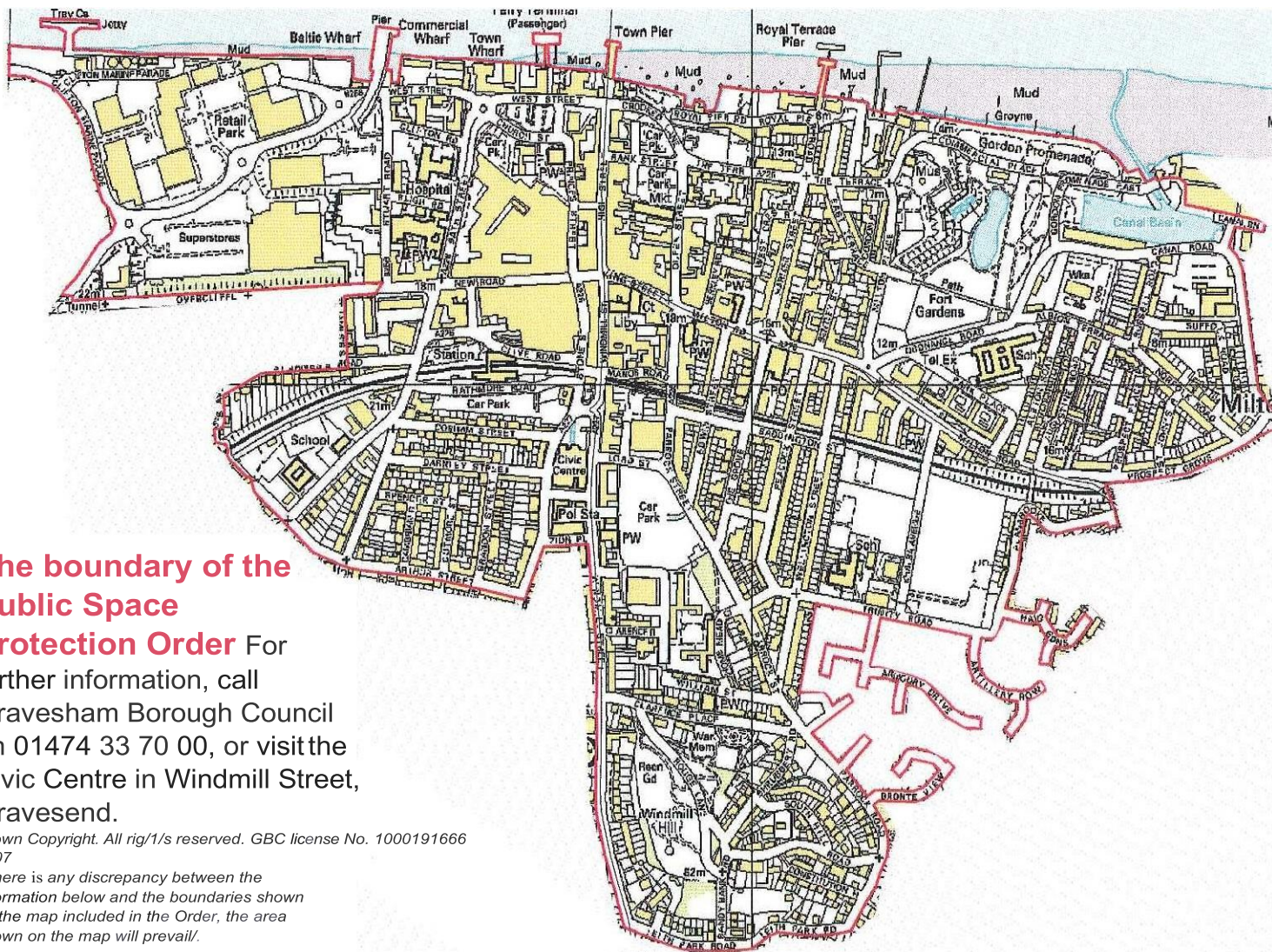


Public Space Protection Order

No person will be permitted to consume alcohol in public spaces in the area identified other than within the curtilage of public houses and licensed premises. A person seen to be consuming alcohol in the area will be in breach of the Order. A request will be made to stop drinking and/or asked to surrender alcohol in open containers. Should the same person be seen consuming alcohol in an Alcohol Restriction Zone again within a reasonable time and after having been advised and warned, a Fixed Penalty Notice will be issued by an Authorised Officer.
