## Notice of making of a Public Space Protection Order for Dog Fouling

Anti-social behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, Part 4

Take notice that

- Gravesham Borough Council (*"the Council"*) has carried out the necessary consultation on its proposal to make **The fouling of Land by Dogs (Gravesham) Public Space Protection Order 2024**  (*"the PSPO"*) in accordance with section 72 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 (*"the Act"*).
- 2) The PSPO has now been made in accordance with section 59 of the Act and it comes into force on 01 February 2024.
- 3) <u>The published PSPO may be viewed online</u>.
- 4) Under the provisions of section 66 of the Act, an interested person may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks from the date that the PSPO is made, to question is validity, on the grounds that:
  - a. The Council did not have the power to make the PSPO, or to include prohibitions or requirements imposed by it, or
  - b. That a requirement of Part 4, Chapter 2 of the Act was not complied with in relation to the PSPO.
- 5) An '*interested person*' is defined by section 66(2) of the Act as being an individual who lives in the restricted area or who regularly works in or visits the area.
