GRAVESHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (VARIATION NO. 6) ORDER 2025

The Gravesham Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 32, 34, 35, 39(3) and 124 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and with the consent of the Kent County Council given under section 39 of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Amend Part C, section 5 and Schedule 1 of the Gravesham Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment & Consolidation) Order 2015 to:-

- **Introduce a three-hour free limit for blue badge holders in the following car parks. Standard charges will apply for all stays over three hours.**
 - **Parrock Street**
 - **Rathmore Road**
 - **West Street**
 - **Milton Place**
 - **Ordnance Road**

Amend Schedule 1 of the Gravesham Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment & Consolidation) Order 2015 to:-

- **Introduce 24-hour maximum stay in Brookvale Car Park, removing the existing four-hour limit.**
- **Remove Lord Street Car Park.**
- **Remove Gurdwara Pay & Display Car Park.**
- **Remove Market Square Car Park.**
- **Remove Horn Yard Car Park.**

Add Schedule 2 to the Gravesham Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment & Consolidation) Order 2015 to:-

- **Introduce £30 annual administrative charge for Town Centre Worker Permits**

Copies of the draft Order which will come into effect on 30 June 2025, together with the statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, and a copy of any other Orders which will be amended by the proposed Order may be examined online at www.gravesham.gov.uk/parking-consultations

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement in relation to the Order.

Gravesham Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Variation No. 6) Order 2025

The Gravesham Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 32, 34, 35, 39(3) and 124 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and with the consent of the Kent County Council given under section 39 of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Amend and replace Part C, section 5 as follows:-

5. Relating to disabled persons parking bays

Where, within a parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a disabled person's vehicle, the driver of a vehicle shall not cause it to park in that parking bay unless it displays a current 'disabled person's badge' in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations of 2000 and the registered disabled person is either the driver or a passenger in the vehicle.

The driver of a vehicle displaying a current 'disabled person's badge' in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations of 2000 may park the vehicle, free of charge in a parking place provided that the period of stay does not exceed three hours. This exemption shall not apply where such a vehicle remains in a parking place for a period exceeding three hours in which case the parking charge in respect of the full duration of time that the vehicle was first parked in the parking place shall be due and payable. A driver displaying a current 'disabled person's' valid badge may also park in a normal bay under the same conditions.

Amend and replace schedule 1

Add Schedule 2 – Table of Permit Charges

Citation and Commencement

This order may be cited as the Gravesham Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Variation No 6) Order 2025, and shall come into operation on 30 June 2025.

The Order retains the terms of the Gravesham Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment & Consolidation) Order 2015 which will continue to apply in every respect but with the amendments to Part C and Schedule 1.
